mark on the roster (data collection sheet)




Data Analysis/Results

Designated Activity	32.5	36.1	22.7	31.9	24.5	28.9	20.5	6.3	17.7	45.1	26.62
Self-selected Activity	31.9	27.7	10.8	29.5	20.5	17.5	14.5	31.3	8.5	30.8	22.30

Data Findings

- Less than 17% of the recreation time students were alone.
- Over 22% of recreation activities were selfselected activities to include fitness classes and meeting friends to eat lunch/dinner.
- Almost 27% participation in designated activities
 - Student 10 participated in designated activities most
 - Student 3 went home the most due to missing his family.






